This parashah, *Devarim*, begins the final book of the Torah, also called *Devarim* (Deuteronomy). It is Moses' "farewell speech".

Sometimes known as *Mishneh Torah* or the Repetition of Torah, it contains a recap of many of the major themes included in the previous books of the Torah. It begins by recounting the various events that had taken place since the Exodus.
