Ki Tavo

Moses instructs the Israelites about the first fruit offering.

He then details the blessings they will receive for following the commandments of the Torah, and the calamities which will result from disregarding them.

Note that the main part of the name of this parashah is תבוא (ta-VO “you (s) come”) and that it is based on the verb בוא, shown at the top of this slide.

Its prefix – ת – helps show the tense as future and that its subject is 2nd “person” singular.
